

New Course for Winter 2018

The Human Figure



A 5 week course we will be concentrating purely on drawing and painting the (clothed) human figure.

The course is split into two 5-week courses.

Whether you're a complete beginner or have some experience, you can work at your own level with as much (or as little) guidance as you like. If you'd just like the company of a regular drawing event, that's fine too.

Organisation

We will usually start with some quick warm-up sketches, then progress may do some longer five to fifteen minute poses. You may find that you are unable to complete a drawing at first. You'll soon learn how much detail you can include for different length poses. Your model will always be clothed.

After a break, we will generally do some longer poses - thirty minutes or longer.

We will try some different exercises each week. The idea is not always to produce beautiful work, so you needn't be worried about getting it 'right'. These different ways of practising train your ability to observe the figure.

The class is more about practice and refinement and developing a style. Hopefully, you will learn and improve every time you observe a figure.

The main language will be English, but if you can forgive my French, I would welcome any French speakers.

The course will run for 2 x 5 weeks on Wednesday mornings.

The class runs from 09:30 to 12:30 with a short break for tea/coffee around 11:00. The gallery will be open from around 09:10 if you would like to get a tea/coffee first.

Materials

The price of the course includes white paper, charcoal, pencils, erasers and a range of hard pastels. You are welcome to bring any other materials you wish to use.

Easels and drawing boards will also be available.

Course cost

To provide a good level of personal attention and to avoid overcrowding I am limiting the number of places to 6 people per course. The cost of the five week course will be 55€ per person (including basic materials), payable in advance. You are more than welcome to attend both courses for 10 weeks should you wish.
